Weapon Attachment Management

When a new weapon is picked up by the player, the UI will present which attachments from your current gun can be transferred. This speeds up the process of attachment management and allows the players to quickly mix and match whatever they like, instead of having the extra step of returning the particular item back to the inventory. The process definitely streamlines the shooter game experience and removes the simulation element - because of this, new players would be advised to use the feature and switch their add-ons as fast as possible.

Using the Absence of Fall Damage

Many battle royale games ended prematurely when a player made a step in the wrong direction and found themselves falling to their death. Apex Legends does not include that element and players are free of damage coming from any kind of a fall. This means that even the highest locations can be traversed by simply jumping down. The same goes for using weapons during a fall - with some good aiming and a bit of luck, players will be able to take down opponents just as they are coming in for a landing.



Pursuing Legendary Loot

In War Thunder, like in real-life warfare, no one can stay on the offense all of the time. Naturally, many players try to play the game like an old-school deathmatch, which includes rushing in and staying aggressive until they are put down. However, this style becomes boring really fast. Players need to learn to maneuver and quickly fall back when they are outgunned. An additional factor in this regard is the ability to align the vehicle so the damage they soak up is not terminal. This is a strategic way of thinking and it provides the best results in the long run.

Using Revival Machines

In Apex Legends, there are two types of revival for the player's teammates. The first one includes helping the team members who are simply down. This is done much in the same manner as any other battle royale game. But, the revival machine includes the ability of a team to revive a long-dead comrade using nothing more than the banner they leave after their death. Once they use this banner in one of the revival machines that are scattered through the map, their comrade will come back. The only drawback is that once a machine is used, it cannot be employed in the same manner again.
